



CITY OF MONTROSE
PARK & RECREATION COMMISSION MINUTES
JUNE 5, 2007

Pursuant to call and notice the Park & Recreation Commission met on June 5, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at the Montrose City Hall. Agenda

May Meeting Minutes

Motion by Burk, seconded by Andreae to approve the May Park and Recreation meeting minutes. Carried 4-0.

Band Shell

The commission discussed possibly putting a band shell in Lions Park. The question was what type of band shell we would want. A pavilion style with back and sides or a gazebo style that is open. More discussion will follow.

Rock Brook Park

The park equipment was ordered and will be ready around June 18. Manson will find out the date for the community build and let Ryan know. He will contact the neighborhood to help with the build. We will also put it on the website.

Northridge Park

Just to get an idea of the cost of developing this park Manson received a quote of \$45,000 to \$55,000 for a side-by-side tennis court and basketball court. With the playground equipment the park will be at least \$100,000 to develop. Manson will try to get more quotes by the July meeting.

Montrose Days

The Park Commission will have a Children's Costume parade on Saturday morning at 11:30 am. The parade will start at city hall and end at the community center. Judging will be at 12:00 pm under the tent. Jim Burk will design a flyer and handout advertising the parade. Nancy is checking with the Wright County Sheriff Dept. to do finger printing on Saturday afternoon after the Kids Pedal Pull.

Welcome Sign

S. Hemmesch asked about the other Welcome Sign on the west side of town. Manson would check but thought the easement was done and the grading in the area was done and the sign could be installed.
