PARK & RECREATION COMMISSION MINUTES AUGUST 7, 2007

Rolling Meadows Park-Ballfield

The Park Commission recommends the building of a baseball field at Rolling Meadows Park. Manson received a couple of quotes for small bleachers and a backstop with the best being from Recreation, Sports & Play, Inc. at approximately \$3,390.98. The ag lime for the field is about \$26-\$27 per ton which would be approximately \$1,000.00. We will need to purchase some sand to mix with the lime for the infield and purchase some bases. The public works/parks department will do the actual labor with the exception of installing the backstop.

Northridge Park

Manson has started getting quotes on playground equipment for the park. She will work on getting another quote.

Rock Brook Park Roof Signs

EFA sent a quote of \$130.00 for the roof signs at Rock Brook Park. By general consensus the item was tabled until next meeting to allow the park commissioners time to go to the park and look at the roof so all know what is being discussed.

Rock Brook Park Handicap Accessibility

Manson is waiting for information from EFA or Landscape Structures regarding the wood fiber that was used. According to EFA Salesperson it meets ADA requirements. This item was also tabled until next meeting.

Rock Brook Park Playground

Manson informed the commission that to date \$39,165.47 has been spent on the park.
